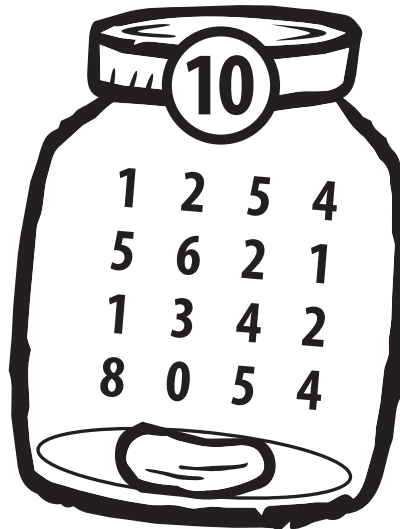
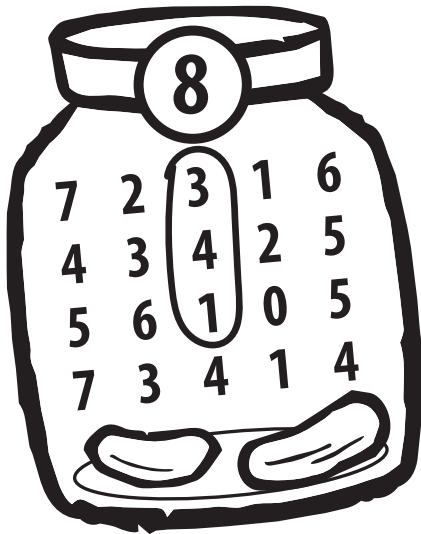
June is Cucumber Month

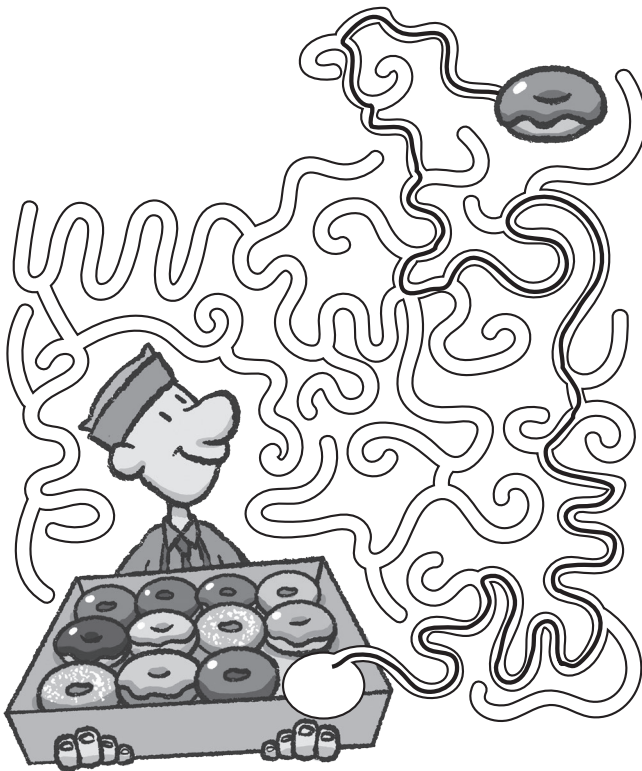
