Look at each number in the chart at right. Then look through the newspaper to show the next number in sequence when counting by 3's. The first row has been done for you.



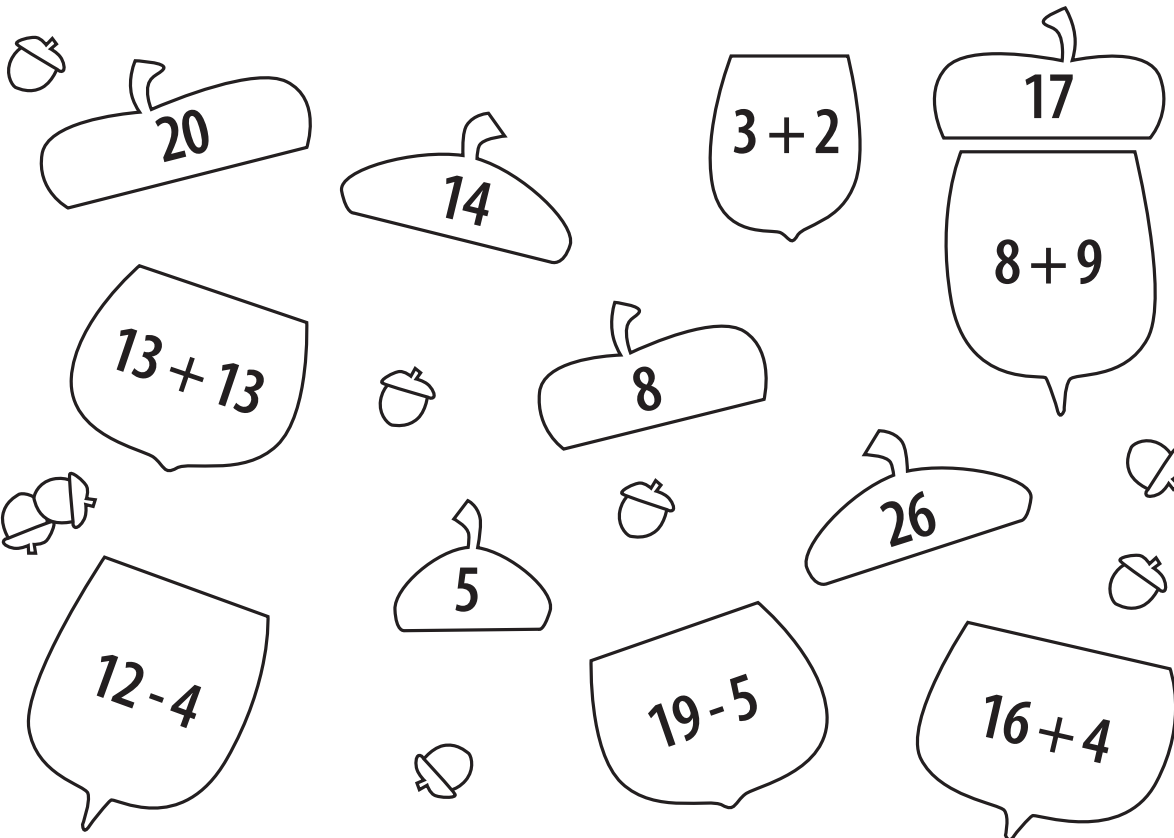

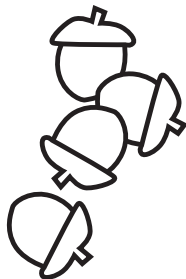

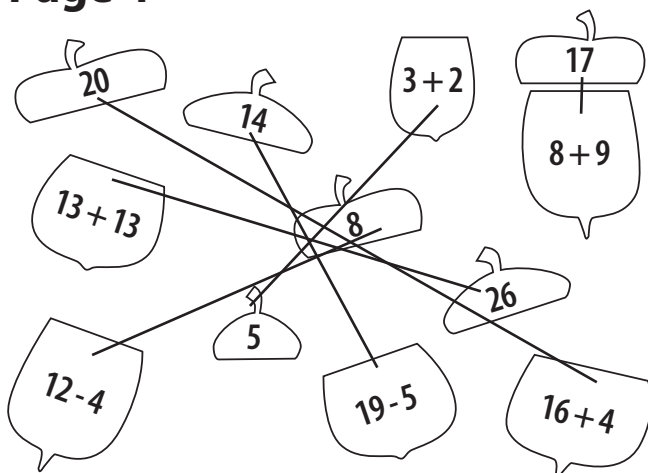
